

GSOC/UAW STRIKE AUTHORIZATION VOTE TIMES AND LOCATIONS

Despite nearly nine months of bargaining, mobilization, and a clear mandate from the majority of our membership, NYU has failed to agree to a fair contract that addresses our core issues of fair compensation, improved and affordable health benefits, tuition and fee remission, and enhanced family-friendly benefits. This leaves no choice but to intensify pressure on the administration and prepare for a potential strike. The first step is a strike authorization vote.

As we announced last week, at the close of our successful rally this past Friday, we opened voting authorizing the Bargaining Committee to call a strike if necessary. Voting will continue through Thursday, December 11th at 6:00 PM. All GSOC-UAW Local 2110 supporters are eligible to vote. If you have not signed up as a supporter yet, send us an email and we will make sure you have a chance to sign up. You may also sign up at the ballot box. There are three ways you can cast your ballot:

1. By casting your vote electronically—if you are a GSOC/UAW supporter, please email us at gsocuaw@gmail.com and we will send you a link for online voting.
2. At the roving ballot boxes which GSOC representatives will be taking around the Washington Square and Poly campuses through Thursday, December 11th at 6:00 PM or
3. At the stationery ballot box Monday – Wednesday, December 1st – 3rd at the following locations:
 - a. Grad Student Commons in the Silver Building, Room 120, 100 Washington Square East, from 12 noon – 2:00 PM and 4:00 PM – 6:00 PM; or
 - b. Poly Cafeteria, Rogers Hall, 6 Metrotech Center from 12 noon – 2:00 PM and 4:00 PM – 6:00 PM.

Make sure your voice is heard through voting and sending a strong message to the university administration that we will not stop until we reach an agreement for a just and fair contract.
