**NOTICE OF NOMINATION AND VACANCY ELECTION FOR THE UNION
BARGAINING COMMITTEE (four [4] positions)**

September 3, 2014

Nominations are hereby declared open to fill vacancies on the GSOC/UAW Local 2110 Bargaining Committee (four [4] positions):

All eligible Union supporters [any NYU graduate student, whether currently employed as an RA, TA or GA, who has signed a Union authorization card, the Fall 2012 Open Letter, the Spring 2013 Healthcare petition or the Spring 2014 Fair Contract petition] are automatically nominated for one of the GSOC/UAW Local 2110 Bargaining Committee.

Any eligible Union supporter who wishes to accept the nomination for one of the four (4) Bargaining Committee positions listed above must indicate her/his intention in writing by fax, electronic scan (pdf), photograph attachment, or by hand delivery of a signed acceptance of nomination for the specified position above to: Election Committee, Local 2110/UAW, 256 West 38th Street, Ste. 704, New York, NY 10018, Fax # 212 -228-0198, local2110@2110uaw.org [mailto:local2110@2110uaw.org] to be received no later than 11:59 pm on September 12, 2014.

A Union supporter may nominate any other Union supporter or supporters s/he desires for the specific position above. If a member chooses to nominate another supporter, s/he must send a signed notification of the nomination in writing, by electronic scan (pdf), fax, or hand delivery to: Election Committee, Local 2110/UAW, 256 West 38th Street, Ste. 704, New York, NY 10018, Fax # 212-228-0198, local2110@2110uaw.org [mailto:local2110@2110uaw.org] . The nominator is required to notify the Union supporter(s) s/he nominated for the specific office(s) so that her/his nominee will be aware of the nomination and of her/his obligation to accept such nomination as described above. If a supporter is nominated and the nominator fails to notify the nominee, such failure will not invalidate or excuse the supporters' responsibility to accept such nomination within the established acceptance deadline outlined in the paragraph above.

Candidate statements

Each candidate may write and submit a candidate statement of no more than 250 words. These statements will be posted on the GSOC/UAW Local 2110 website if there are contested elections. Address, phone number and email address must be included, but will not be counted toward the 250 words.

It is the responsibility of the candidate to submit the candidate statement. All candidate statements must be received by the time nominations close at 11:59 pm on September 12, 2014.

Election Dates, Times and Locations

In the event that the number of eligible candidates who accept nomination for the specified position do not exceed the number of open positions (four [4] open positions), such candidates will be deemed elected by acclamation and no election will be held.

If more than four (4) eligible supporters accept nomination, an election will be conducted with the top four (4) vote getters being elected.
